Community focus is in the forefront of Rotary's mission. Rotary proudly supports projects that focus on aiding the community in areas for Youth, Seniors, Healthcare, Food Banks, Community Innovations, Education, and Families at Risk.

Rotary Club of Yreka announces its Mini Grant Program. Mini Grant requests are accepted throughout the year on a quarterly basis. Grant deadlines are February 1st, May 1st, August 1st, and November 1st. Yreka Rotary will award between 6-10 Mini Grants per quarter. Awards will be determined on a competitive basis for each Quarter. Award announcements will be available within 4 weeks of the deadlines for submissions. Grant awardees are required to make a short (10 minute) presentation describing the grant project at a regular meeting of the Yreka Rotary.

Funding for individual projects will be allocated based upon the competitive score of the proposal and availability of funds. The Yreka Rotary Board reserves the right to award more or less than requested.

The funding focus areas are: Youth, Seniors, Families at Risk, Education, Food Bank, Community Innovations and Healthcare.

Organizations, schools, and community service groups are all welcome to apply.

Projects must address one or more of the focus areas, have a specific goal, timeline, budget, and measurable outcomes.

Funding will not be made to individuals. Projects must be completed prior to June 30th of each year. A final report must be submitted no later than 30 days after completion of the project.
